Spectrum Race Camp is an inclusive alpine ski race training event for athletes with or without intellectual disabilities and occurs at one of the world's premier summer snowsports training venues. The Camp exists to provide athletes access to top-level coaching, expansion of technical skills, and increased experience in racecourse tactics. The Camp culture encourages personal responsibility, the development of friendships, and social/emotional growth. The most fun camp you will ever attend!

Camp consists of six mornings of on-snow skill development activities, drill courses and gate training. Afternoons are filled with fun group activities for expanding physical fitness and self, individual time, and ski/board equipment preparation. Group dinners and video analysis of athlete training runs from the day occur each evening. A fun excursion planned for mid-session will provide a break from on-snow training.

Athletes must be independent in self-care and able to participate independently in a coached situation or bring a support provider to camp for assistance in these areas.
